Established in 2016, Genuine Academy, Inc. became a 501(c)(3) nonprofit created to be an aid in the academic development of at-risk youth in under-served communities. We utilize an innovative curriculum and progressive teaching techniques amongst 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade students to promote academic enrichment, social engagement, and community development. Our goal is to create a platform that enables students to explore their creativity and develop a sense of purpose by tailoring the curriculum to fit the student's specific needs.

We are committed to making our program available to families who find it difficult to pay 100% of tuition. Therefore, *The Learning for Leaders Scholarship* was designed to assist families in their efforts to provide their scholars with the tools necessary to receive a quality education and maximize their intellectual potential. This fund will play a significant role in building the oncampus culture for years to come.

Scholarships are limited and the process to receive funds is competitive. Hence, awards are given on a first-come, first-served basis. Applicants are encouraged to apply early to ensure your family gets an opportunity to benefit from this program! Award amounts vary but will not exceed 50% of a family's calculated need, as determined by household income assessment. For example, if your demonstrated need is calculated to be 80%, you may be eligible to receive an award equaling up to 40% of tuition.

If selected for the *Learning for Leaders Scholarship*, parents and students will be required to meet certain requirements in order to maintain a satisfactory scholarship status.

#### Responsibilities include:

- Parent Hours Parents will be required to complete 2 volunteer hours per week. The hours can be applied to a field trip, morning reflection, in-class activity, lunch session, or afternoon dismissal.
- Academic Accountability Students on scholarship will be expected to maintain a 3.0 GPA, high attendance, and exemplary conduct.
- Completed Essay As a thank you to donors that regularly contribute to the Learning for Leaders Fund, we would like the students to write an essay that outlines their year on campus and how impactful the institution has been to them.
